



Inability to Attend: Attendee Refund Policy

Refund Insurance is now included with your registration fee. You will receive a 100% refund of your registration fees, if you are unable to attend this event due to any of the following reasons:

What is covered:

- 1) **The death, injury, or illness** happening to the attendee, a member of their immediate family who is under the age of 70, or any person(s) in the group due to attend the event with the attendee;
- 2) **Adverse weather** including snow, frost, fog or storm where the Police service or other local Government agency have issued warning not to travel;
- 3) **Terrorism (TRIA)**
- 4) **Mechanical breakdown, accident, fire or theft** in route of a private vehicle taking the attendee to this event;
- 5) **Jury Duty** which the attendee was unaware of at the time of registration;
- 6) **The attendee being summoned to appear at court** proceedings as a witness which the **attendee** was unaware of at the time of registration;
- 7) **Burglary or fire at the residence of the attendee** in the forty-eight (48) hours immediately before this event that required attendance of the emergency services;
- 8) **The attendee being a member of the armed forces** and being posted overseas unexpectedly;
- 9) **Unexpected disruption of the public transport network** the attendee could not have reasonably known about before the date or time of this event;
- 10) **The attendee being relocated for work** more than one hundred (100) miles from the booked event which the attendee was unaware of at the time of booking, **or the attendee is unexpectedly terminated from their job.**

This insurance coverage starts: The moment you pay your registration fee

This insurance coverage ends: Upon the show opening on the first day of the event
